#### **Student PBL Awards**

Our students have been working hard all year, showing they are safe, respectful learners. 209 students have received Gold Awards (92%), 77 students have received School Banners (34%) and 2 students received their School Medallion (1%). #### **Library**

All students have now received their PRC certificate. 2020 proved to be our best year ever with all students completing the Premier's Reading Challenge. 29 students received a gold certificate for 4 years participation and 24 students were awarded a platinum certificate for 7 years participation. If you need to purchase uniforms ready for school next year, the following information may be helpful.



### Tips:

- 1. Remember it is quality not quantity: just 5 minutes a day of one on one time.
- Be 'child-led' during your Our Time: doing what your child wants (so long as it is safe).
- Try not to take over or make it a teaching moment, the aim is just to <u>have fun</u>. This
  will be easier if you do not choose an activity that requires an adult to be in charge
  or has lots of rules.
- Show them you are engaged by limiting distractions and talking about what you are doing together while you do it.
- Example activities: Take pictures together, build an indoor cubby house with an old sheet, drawing, etc.
